Internship Program-Host Site Information

Host Site Expectations:

Provide student with 40 hours of work per credit received (ex: 3 credits=120 hours, 2 credits= 80 hours) of supervised, meaningful, academically challenging (or enhancing) duties. For 120 hours, this is approximately 8-12 hours per week during the fall and spring semesters, and 10-15 during the summer semester.

Students have the option of interning during the fall, spring, and summer semesters. Best time frame to post your opportunity is $1-\frac{3}{3}$ months prior to when you'd like to host an intern (ex: Post opportunity in October for a spring semester intern). Most students participate in the 3-credit internship course.
