Bristol Community College has an undergraduate population of 11,949 (unduplicated headcount of credit students for 2011-12) and 13,379 in noncredit enrollments.

BUDGET

Bristol Community College's operating budget for Fiscal Year 2012 is \$62 million, including state support of \$13.6 million and \$29.5 million in federal, state, and private grants.

In FY12, more than \$24 million in federal, state, and local nancial aid was disbursed to 6,266 students. In Fall 2012, 52% of students are receiving Pell Grants and 24% of students are receiving loans. The Bristol Community College Foundation awarded an additional \$154,503 in scholarships and awards to 234 recipients. The Foundation issued 139 loans totaling \$25,554 to assist students.
