 - On May 6, it was announced that a webpage had been created specifically for the Presidential Search Process.
 - Thompson Facilitator/Senior Consultant representative from the executive search firm R.H. Perry and Associates.
 - In an effort to provide additional opportunities for the College Community to provide input for the Presidential Search process, an online survey was developed and sent to all College Constituents. The anonymous results of the survey were then forwarded to the Chairman of the Presidential Search Committee and the Search Consultant
 - The Presidential Secrete Committee had its initial morting on May 12, 2016. Also in attendance was Mr. Thompson, from R. H. Perry and Associates; Mr. Tafa Assolaiu

 Affirmative Action Officer; and Ms. Kathleen Wordell, Committee Liaison.

 Massachusetts Community College General Counsel Ken Tashiy attended the meeting and instructed the Presidential Search Committee on the Open Meeting Law, Public

Manifest Run Landing and an angelo

Records Law, and the BHE Guidelines for Presidential Search and Selection. A tentative sebedule was developed which was to culminate in the Pracidential Search Committee presentation of 3-5 finalist candidates to the Board of Trustees by December 2016.

- The Executive Search Profile was then developed and approved by the Commissioner of Higher Education and by the Education and 15, 2016.

 A deadline date of August 30, 2016, was determined for submittal of applications for the position. - The Presidential Search Committee began reviewing and evaluating the applicants' submitted material after the August 30, 2016, application due date. A total of 45 applications were received: Lapplicant with draw. The Bresidential Search Committee identified 23 top candidates. R. H. Perry and Associates conducted a preliminary due diligence on these candidates.
